- 2nd Trombone:** Enters in measure 1 with a forte (*f*) dynamic.
- Bass Trombone:** Enters in measure 1 with a forte (*f*) dynamic.
- Euphonium:** Enters in measure 1 with a forte (*f*) dynamic.
- E♭ Bass:** Enters in measure 1 with a forte (*f*) dynamic.
- B♭ Bass:** Enters in measure 1 with a forte (*f*) dynamic.
- Glockenspiel:** Enters in measure 5.
